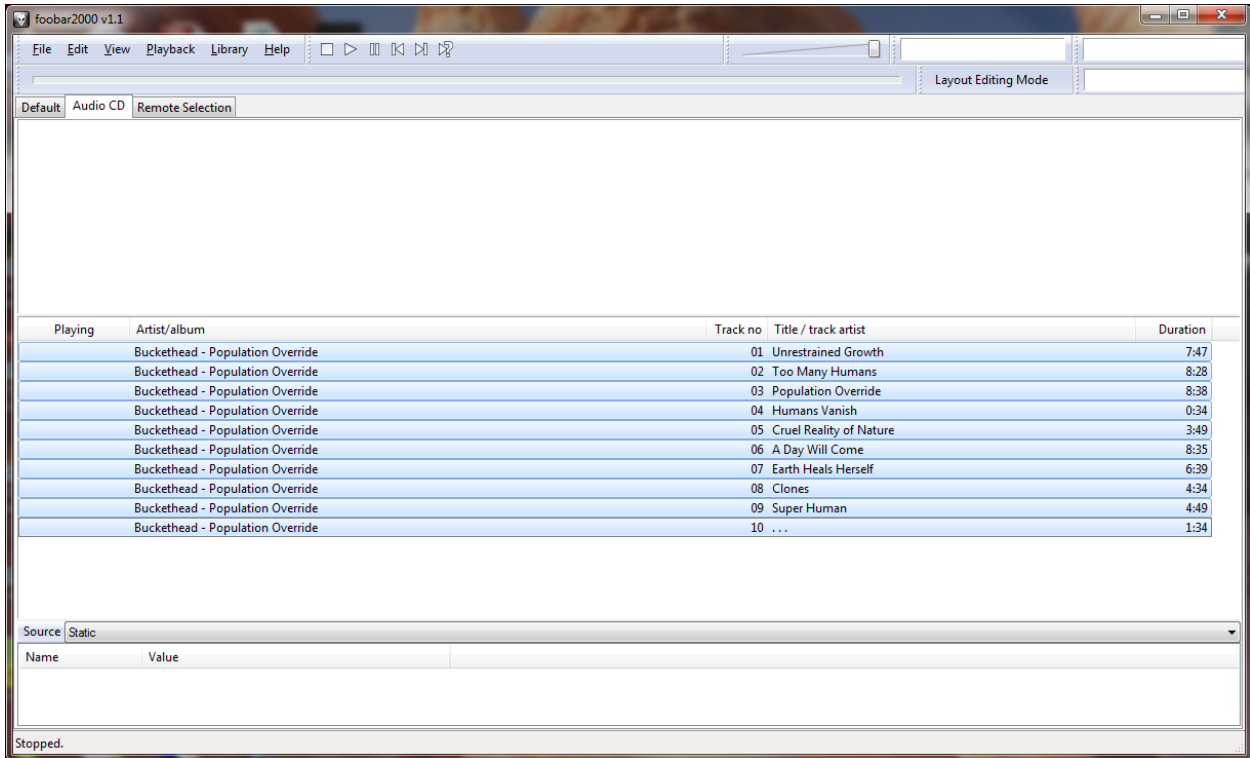
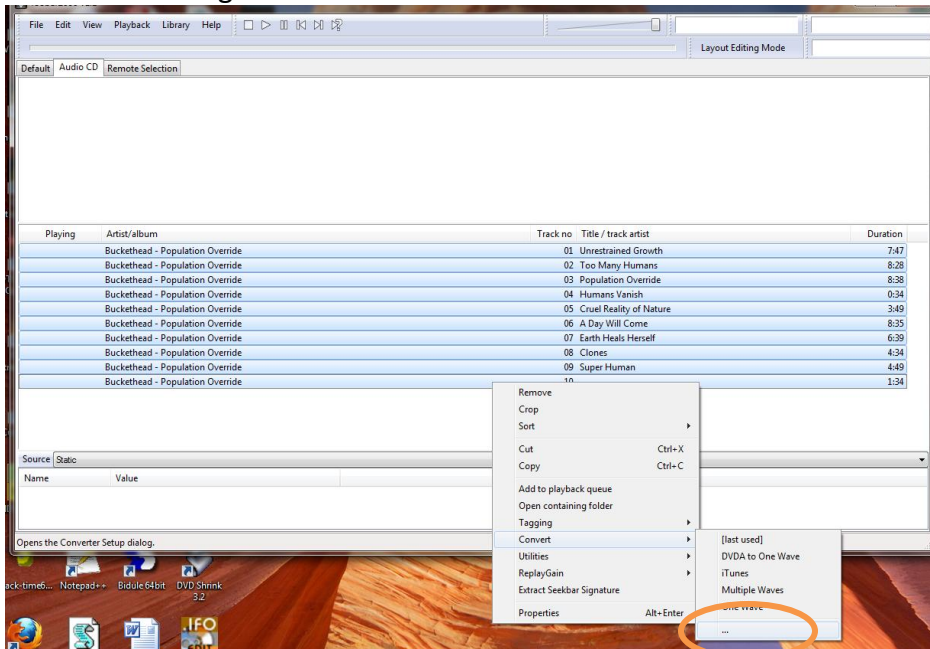


foobar2000 File Conversions

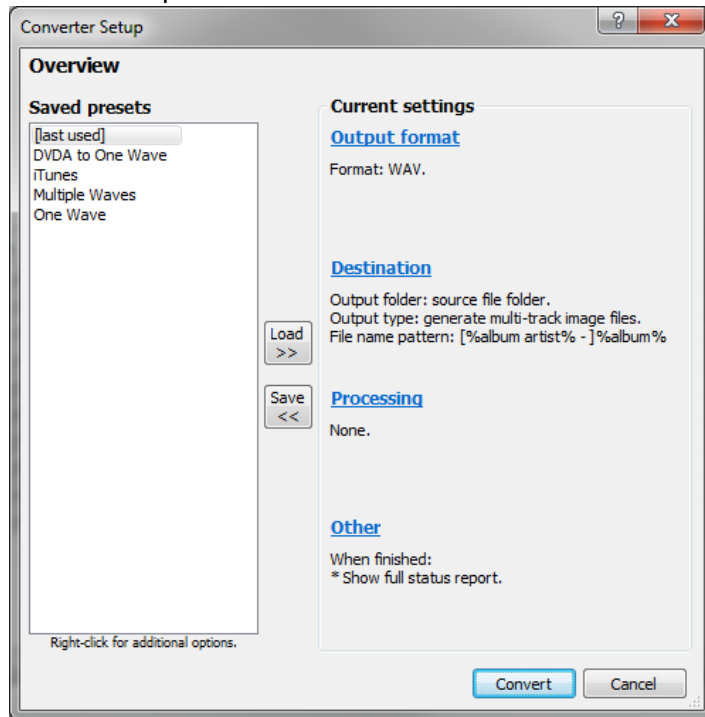
- 1) Multiple files to one wave
 - a. Drag all the files into foobar
 - b. If not already highlighted, highlight all files:



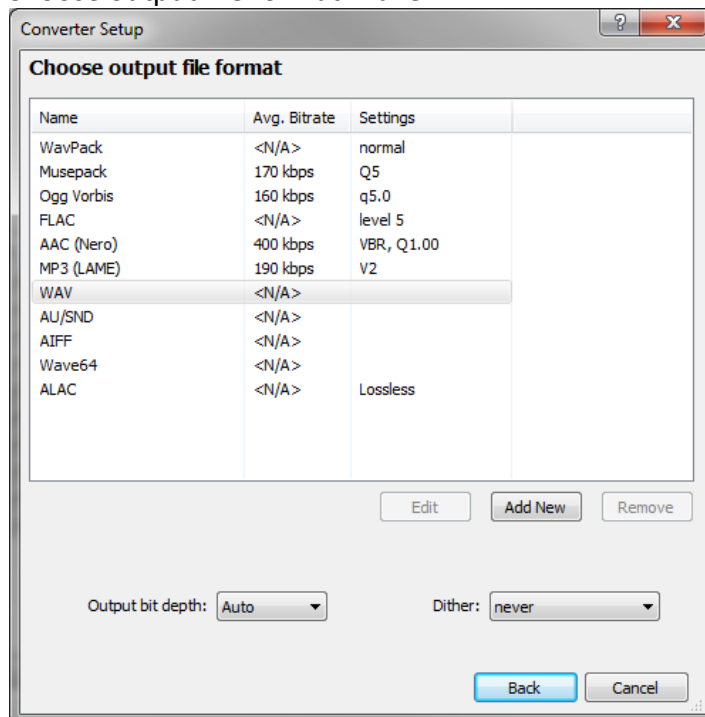
- c. Right click on a file and select convert → ...



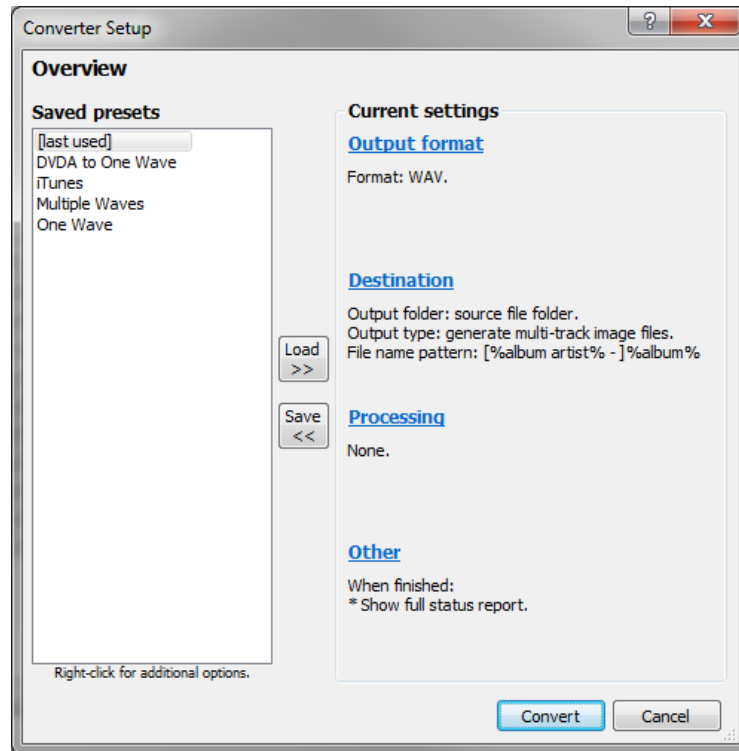
d. Click on Output format



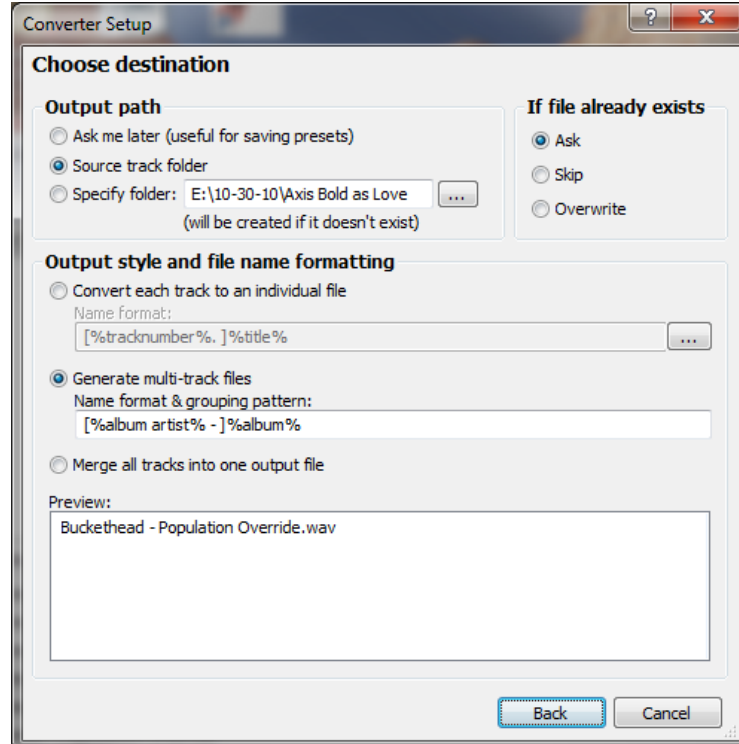
e. Choose output file format Wave



- f. Select “Back” then click on “Destination”

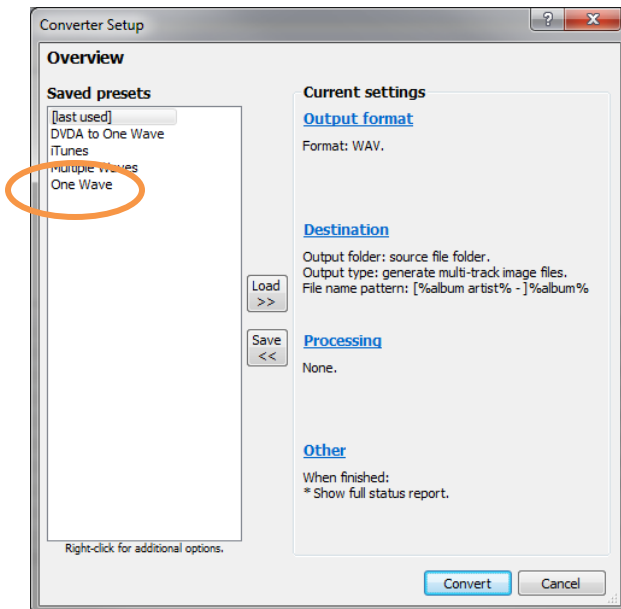


- g. Select “generate multi-track files”, then back.



- h. Processing: none.

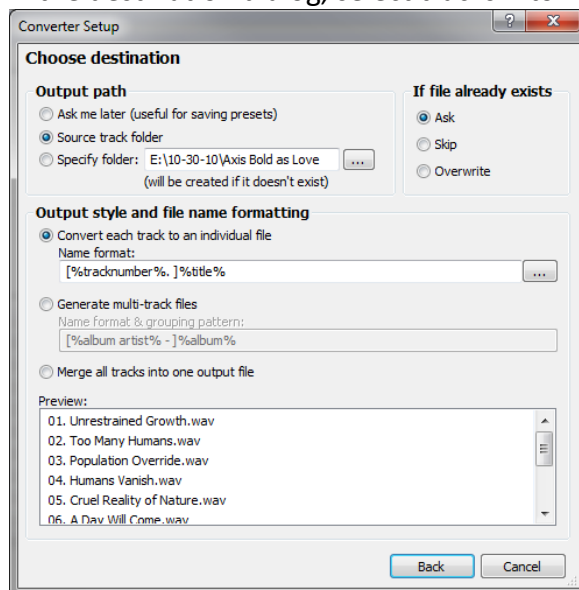
- i. Save and rename “One Wave”



- j. Now hit “Convert”. You will end up with one wave file and a cue file. From now on, you can just select Convert → One Wave.

2) Breaking one DTS wave into individual files.

- Edit the cue file to point to the dts file
- Drag the cue file into foobar
- Make sure the tracks play
- Highlight all the tracks
- Select the output format you want
- In the destination dialog, select tracks into individual files:



- g. Save the converter setup as “multiple wave” or “multiple flac”, etc.
- h. Hit convert. Next time you can just do Convert → multiple flac.
